Capability and Description

2015 Edition criteria applicable to myCare Integrity Version 5.0: a1, a2, a3, a5, a6, a9, a11, a12, a13, a14, b1, b2, b6, b9, d1, d2, d3, d4, d5, d6, d7, d8, g3, g4, g5, g6

myCare Integrity Version 5.0 is a cloud-based EHR that supports healthcare professionals in ophthalmology and optometry in outpatient ambulatory environments. It allows users to perform a wide range of functions such as to:

- document, review, and edit patient health information including but not limited to problem lists, medication lists, medication allergy lists, family health history, and all aspects of the patient's eye exam,
- perform CPOE (computerized provider order entry) for medications, laboratory orders and imaging procedures,
- electronically create prescriptions and prescription-related information for electronic transmission to pharmacies,
- measure CQMs (clinical quality measures) and to export these in standard file formats,
- be alerted to possible CDS (clinical decision support) interventions, and
- Report information to PHAs (public health agencies) and clinical data registries.

Types of Costs or Fees and Additional Types of Costs or Fees

Licensing and implementation of the functionality and content covered by this certification will require a one-time fee for standard implementation and ongoing service fees covering the right to use the solution, support, and ongoing maintenance.

Required configuration to establish interfaces to transmit laboratory results may require one-time costs.

Development required to Integrate with a third party vendor may be subject to additional one-time and / or ongoing monthly fees if the technical requirements of the integration are outside of the current scope of the EHR.

Basic Eye Reach Patient Portal (myCare Portal) service is provided at an ongoing monthly fee to clients with a contract originating on or after January 1, 2018. Premium Portal services can be purchased for an additional fee.

Clinical Decision Support documentation via InfoButton technology is available upon request. Subscription Fees apply and are subject to automatic annual renewal

This certified product-version may also require ongoing monthly costs to support the electronic exchange of ePHI (b)(1), (b)(2).

Limitations (Contractual/Business)

The Direct Messaging capability is restricted. Users will be unable to exchange messages with users of third-party HISP services which are not affiliated with DirectTrust.

Limitations (Technical/Practical)

myCare Integrity Version 5.0 utilizes Updox as its HISP. It is not possible to integrate Integrity EMR Version 5.0 with a different HISP. The Direct Messaging capability is restricted and users will be unable to exchange messages with users of third-party HISP services which are not affiliated with DirectTrust.

The Regulatory Compliance Platform Version 1.2 is used as part of an EHR solution package. It allows users to perform a wide range of functions such as monitor MIPS Performance, CQM calculation, PHA reporting, Bulk Export of CCD files, Send/receive messages and attached documents to/from the HISP via Direct Edge Protocol, create gold standard documents required for referrals and transitions of care

Third Party Eye Reach Patient Portal (myCare Portal) Software is required to meet MIPS related Secure Messaging, Patient Electronic Access and Patient Education Resource objectives.
